NELSON, NEW ZEALAND 2-12 November 2017

This information is provided to assist members in their consideration to participate at the World Championships in 2017. The items covered in this memo is to provide an assurance that the arrangements for this Championship are in hand and we are able to be confident that an event of suitable status will be conducted.

Range size: I am able to confirm that our range will be extended from 20 to 25 benches as per the rules. Necessary earthworks are nearly complete and we expect all range preparations will be completed this summer.

Reloading Facilities: This will be by way of a large Marque, however on a different site to the last occasion. A suitable area has been shaped in front of the Clubhouse including drainage pipe installed. Be sure you and any visitors bring good hearing protection with you as it will be needed.

Reloading Supplies: We have already received 150lbs of V133 and this is in storage to be sure of our supply. Primers are on order from two sources and although they are in short supply in our country we are still confident that we will be ok.

Other supplies: It is our intention to have available supplies of solvent etc Later we will seek each countries requirement. Like the powder we may need to purchase in bulk and decant into suitable sizes but that should not cause any major concerns.

Berger Bullets: We are working on the idea of having available a supply of Berger Bullets (BT, s, Web, Column) and again we will seek requirements from countries

Sand: We have sourced a supply of Garnet and this will be available as needed.

Farley Bases: We can arrange to have bases cut if needed. I currently have no idea of costs but will let you know in due course.

Wind Flags: We will arrange to have all available sets of flags that are in our country at the range. This is approx 12 sets so if countries are likely to bring their own we would appreciate advise to ensure we have all lanes covered.

Entry to New Zealand: For most countries entry to New Zealand will be of little difficulty with the Visa-Waiver program applicable. I attach to this memo a copy of the information available. If your country is not mentioned, we will need to go through a formal application process. Our Committee will do whatever we can to assist. It is important that we get the process going early.

Firearm entry to New Zealand: This again is a straight forward process and can be arranged on line. See <u>www.police.govt.nz</u> There is a fee of \$25 NZD at the moment. I made approaches to the Police to have the fee cancelled however I was unsuccessful for which I apologise. I do advise however that our Police Firearms Branch has been briefed on our championship together with our local Police Office. We will ensure that our Airport Police are aware of your arrivals to ensure a smooth passage into New Zealand when we have the information
